Review and Approval of Minutes from 4/04/16

Principal's Report -

1. Enrollment: We had info session at the elementary school with 275 attendees. The elementary school will be able to have some younger sibling preference for those who passed the G&T exam. At the middle school we had around 90 students admitted and hosted info sessions for those accepted families. Staff have been working to answer the questions of newly admitted students. Currently we will be losing 5 students to Hunter and Baccalaureate from the 6th grade class moving up.

2. End of Year Assessments: The elementary students will be having end of the year assessments in the form of running records, content area reading and mathematics. At the middle school end of the year assessments will also take place in content areas, similar to those that were administered at the beginning of the year.
3. Time Change: The elementary school will possibly run 8:10am - 2:30pm next year in order to fit with the timing of PS 17.
4. CEP: Core Value Action teams will work on targeted CEP goals from the Capacity Framework. Teams worked on looking at what data we have and should gather for the next meeting to work on next year's goals.
 - Inquiry Team: Rigorous Instruction
 - Responsibility Team: Supportive Environment
 - Inclusion Team: Strong Family-Community Ties
 - Matt & Kristina: Collaborative Teachers and Effective School Leadership

Parent Report –

1. Gallery night was a success and the next event will be the Silent Auction on Sunday May 15th. There will be a variety of food for adults and kids, a kids DJ, music, raffle of teacher donated prizes. The online auction will be also go live for larger items.
2. Enrichment committee has been investigation options and created a parent survey to help prioritize interest in funding.
