Principal's Report (Bill):

- Bill wants to hire another full-time school aide. There was a freeze on hiring. For now, he has hired substitute aides at ES and MS.
- There are 2 Integrated Co-Teaching (ICT) vacancies at MS. Bill was made aware of these at the end of summer, and he is interviewing now to fill those vacancies. Starting tomorrow, Ali, ES technology teacher with Special Education license, will move to the MS to help for a couple of weeks. Technology will be covered by a substitute.
