- Fruits, Vegetables and Eggshells
- Coffee, Tea and Nuts
 - Dried Flowers and Houseplants
- Bread, Grains, Pasta

Not accepted at food scrap drop-off sites:

- Meat, Fish, and Dairy
- Pet Waste and Kitty Litter
- Pressure-treated Plywood, Lumber, or Sawdust
- Clean Paper, Glossy Paper, or Cardboard
 - Metal, Glass or Plastic
- Medical Waste, Diapers, and Personal Hygiene Products
- BPI-certified compostable plastic products
