Applying to Kindergarten at Q300

WHEN to APPLY : *Dec 8, 2022 - January 20, 2023*

WHO can APPLY : *Children born in 2018 and who live in NYC*

HOW to APPLY :

If your child is a Current pre-K student at a DOE/district school, Pre-K Center, NYC Early Education Center (NYCEECs), or charter school:

1. List a G&T program on your child's Kindergarten application at myschools.nyc
2. Current pre-K teachers will nominate students who are eligible applicants for G&T admissions.

If your child is a Current pre-K student at a private or parochial school program, or not yet in school:

1. List a G&T program on your child's Kindergarten application using myschools.nyc
2. After the application closes, DOE's Division of Early Childhood Education will contact applicants to set up an interview.
3. Based on the interview, early childhood education experts nominate eligible applicants for G&T admissions.

How Kindergarten G&T Offers Are Made:

- After your application is submitted, eligibility is determined by the DOE and eligible applicants will be notified in Spring 2023
- Offers are determined based on families' application choices, seat availability, and admissions priorities. All G&T programs give priority to eligible siblings of current students.
- Q300 prioritizes 40% of Kindergarten seats for students who qualify for free lunch, and/or reside in citywide Section 8 housing or NYCHA.
