



Applying to Kindergarten at Q300

WHEN to APPLY: Dec 8, 2022 - January 20, 2023

WHO can APPLY: Children born in 2018 and who live in NYC

HOW to APPLY: You can submit your kindergarten application one of three ways:

- Online with MySchools (myschools.nyc) in English, Spanish, Chinese, Bengali, Russian, Arabic, Urdu, Haitian Creole, Korean, or French. We'll let you know when the application opens and you can apply online!
- By phone at 718-935-2009. If you are applying by phone, interpretation services are available in more than 200 languages.

How Kindergarten G&T Offers Are Made:

- After your application is submitted, eligibility is determined by the DOE and eligible applicants will be notified in Spring 2023
- Offers are determined based on families' application choices, seat availability, and admissions priorities. All G&T programs give priority to eligible siblings of current students.
- Q300 prioritizes 40% of Kindergarten seats for students who are eligible for Free or Reduced-Price Lunch (based on family income), living in temporary housing and/or live in public housing
